
Opening of the Green



International Workers' Day, also known as Labour Day in some countries and often referred to as May Day, is a celebration of labourers and the working classes that is promoted by the international labour movement and occurs every year on 1 May, or the first Monday in May.

May Day is still celebrated in many villages with the crowning of the May Queen. The gentlemen of the village may also been found celebrating with Jack-in-the-Green, otherwise found on the signs of pubs across the country called the Green Man.

The Jack-in-the-Green was (and indeed is) a traditional participant in May celebrations and May Day parades mainly in the United Kingdom. A large framework is covered in combinations of foliage and flowers and is sometimes topped with an intricate crown of flowers. The Jack then parades or dances, often accompanied by the May Queen, dancers, musicians and people dressed as assorted unusual characters. Modern Jacks are usually closely associated with Morris teams.

Competition Tips

- _1). Be prepared with the relevant Bowling Equipment that you may have to use.
- 2). Be aware of the Competition Rules, a copy is on the Competitions Board and on the Club Website.
- 3). Ensure you are free to make the Finals Days, so all your hard work and achievements are not wasted. Including the reserve days.
- 4). Arrange Matches in plenty of time, to avoid disappointment, as rinks get busy. Book your matches as Competitions not Roll Ups.
- 5). If in a Singles Competition, don't forget to book a Marker. List of Markers and Markers Guidelines on Competitions Board.
- 6). Use the Competitions Scorecard only, remember to head up with the relevant full Competition Name and Players.
- 7). Ensure Scorecard is signed by the Skips, and that the score is agreed by both teams.
- 8). Enter into Bowlr and Log score under appropriate Competition on Competition Sheets on Competitions Board.
- 9). Place Scorecard in the Competitions holder and not in the League holder.
- 10). Enjoy the game.
